LENTEN MIDWEEK MEAL & WORSHIP

Hands are powerful instruments capable of building or breaking, healing or harming, and Scripture speaks often of the “hand of the Lord” at work in creation, judgment and salvation. The sermon series “The Hand of the Lord” explores how God ultimately reveals His hand in Jesus Christ, who took on real hands to save, heal, bless and bear the cross for us. Join us each Wednesday during Lent for a meal at 5:45 p.m. followed by Lenten worship at 6:30 p.m. as we explore how, in Christ, our broken hands are restored and put to work as instruments of His grace, service and praise.



SUNDAY LENTEN SERMON SERIES

On Sunday mornings during Lent, join us for a deep and timely journey through the book of Job, one of the Bible’s most powerful reflections on suffering, faith and trust in God. During the sermon series “Blessed Be the Name of the Lord”, we’ll discover how Job speaks directly to our lives today, offering wisdom, honesty and hope for walking through life’s hardest seasons.



NEW ADULT BIBLE CLASS

The Mormon Church (aka The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints) boasts more than 15 million members and 85,000 missionaries, ranking it in the top five “Christian denominations” in the U.S., according to the National Council of Churches. But what makes this group distinctive and how does it differ from other Christian churches? Questions like these and more are addressed

in our new Adult Bible Class study “Mormons: Who They Are, What They Believe”. This Bible study will look at the group’s origins; the discrepancy between Mormon beliefs and orthodox Christian teaching and faith; the meaning of some of its rituals (baptism of the dead, endowments for the living and dead, temple garments, celestial marriage); and the prominence of the temple in the life of a Mormon. It will feature comments from individuals who have been deeply immersed in the Mormon belief system. It will show how some, upon exiting the Mormon Church, found themselves bewildered and disillusioned, often cut off and ostracized by their families, ready to abandon religious faith altogether. Real-life stories from those on the inside and other expert commentary add depth and authenticity to this engaging study. A discussion guide complements the videos, further exploring this fascinating topic through Scripture-related passages and Internet links. This six-week study will be held Sundays at 9:15 a.m. in Room 19 through March 29.
