## MEN'S RETREAT: A WEEKEND OF FAITH, BROTHERHOOD, AND THE OUTDOORS

Join other SOTV men April 10-12 at Hidden Acres Christian Center for a retreat designed to strengthen faith through fellowship, time in God's Word and shared experiences in God's creation. The weekend begins Friday evening with check-in and an opening program, followed by relaxed activities that will give men space to connect and build relationships.



Saturday blends spiritual growth with hands-on fun like fishing, hiking, archery and axe throwing. Men may start the day with an optional prayer hike, then gather for meals, meaningful teachings and featured speaker, Cam Scott.
